Calcium Citrate:

Calcium citrate is used to prevent or treat low blood calcium levels in people who do not get enough calcium from their diets. It may be used to treat conditions caused by low calcium levels such as bone loss (osteoporosis), weak bones (osteomalacia/rickets), decreased activity of the parathyroid gland (hypoparathyroidism), and a certain muscle disease (latent tetany). It may also be used in certain patients to make sure they are getting enough calcium (e.g., women who are pregnant, nursing, or postmenopausal, people taking certain medications such as phenytoin, phenobarbital, or prednisone).

Calcium plays a very important role in the body. It is necessary for normal functioning of nerves, cells, muscle, and bone. If there is not enough calcium in the blood, then the body will take calcium from bones, thereby weakening bones. Having the right amount of calcium is important for building and keeping strong bones. Calcium Citrate is also recognized as a calcium source that does not increase the risk of kidney stones, and it protects against stoneforming potential. Calcitriol

Calcitriol is a man-made active form of <u>vitamin D</u>. Most people get enough <u>vitamin D</u> from exposure to the sun and from fortified food products (such as dairy products, <u>vitamins</u>). Vitamin D helps control <u>parathyroid hormone</u> and the levels of certain <u>minerals</u> (such as <u>calcium</u>, phosphorus) that are needed for building and keeping strong bones.

Magnesium oxide:

Magnesium deficiency might affect bone directly (by reducing bone stiffness, increasing osteoclasts and decreasing osteoblasts) and indirectly (by interfering with PTH and vitamin D, promoting inflammation/oxidative stress and subsequent bone loss). Preventing muscle cramps is another potential benefit of taking magnesium oxide. This form of magnesium contributes to muscle contraction, and helps to prevent muscle spasms.



Zinc Sulphate:

Improved skeletal growth and bone homeostasis, Promote bone regeneration & growth by activating enzymes.
